Another group company, Raubex Building, located in Midrand, Gauteng, offers competitive turnkey solutions for projects, ranging from large housing initiatives

for mining companies to low-cost housing and commercial and industrial developments, while Cape Town-headquartered SPH Kundalilla, a Raubex subsidiary, supplies comprehensive surface mining and materials handling solutions for mining projects.

Raubex Group's familiarity with local conditions across the Southern African Development Community (SADC) has been built over its 40 years of experience in South Africa and its activity in other SADC countries since as early as the 1990s. Today, the group generates a substantial portion of its revenue from contracts in Botswana, Mozambique, Namibia, Malawi and Zambia.
